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PUR	POSE
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To assist in installation of the headliner in the Cirrus SR20, SR22 & SR22T.

HEADLINER INSTALLATION

- A. Installation of headliner typically occurs after all other tasks have been accomplished and system is serviced but prior to the rest of the cabin interior reinstallation.
- B. Remove the rubber window trim and disconnect the speaker and light/lights. Remove the headliner, both door pillar panels, both aft panels and baggage window panel.
- C. The old headliner will be replaced with a new headliner and internal ducting. The old right and left rear panel will be replaced by new panels with room for the internal ducting to the headliner. The old Bulkhead Cover will be replaced with a new formed sheet metal cover. See Table 1 for the Cirrus Part Numbers and the Kelly Aerospace replacement part.

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D. After removing the old headliner, detach the speaker, light/lights, coat hangers and any other items. Transfer those items to the new headliner AC-01100. Fit reading light switches with AC-01413 collar with black side showing before installing in headliner. If reading lights and switches are not present, choose one of the following three options. Option 1, cap the holes with (2) 85985K22 and (2) 85985K29 plugs. Option 2, purchase and install Cirrus interior reading lights. Option 3, contact Kelly Aerospace Thermal Systems to purchase a custom headliner excluding reading light and switch holes (contact KATS for current pricing). Install (2) AC-01106 Vents in locations shown. See Figure 1 for top and bottom views.

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E. If required, mask rear pilot, rear passenger and back window with painter's tape and use black paint to create a 1.5" wide border around the edge of the windows to hide any exposed edges of the Headliner or Panels. See Figure 2.

F. Feed the two SCAT-10 Tubes from the Evaporator through the AC-01101 Right Rear Panel. Poke two small holes in the Right Rear Panel to match existing Click-Bonds and fasten with (2) 91249A161 Pan Head Screws and (2) AN960-C6L S.S. Washers. See Figure 3.

G. Poke two small holes in the AC-01102 Left Rear Panel to match existing Click-Bonds and fasten with (2) 91249A161 Pan Head Screws and (2) AN960-C6L S.S. Washers, trimming to fit when required. Re-attach rubber baggage door trim. See Figure 4.

H. Connect the SCAT-10 Tubes to the front and rear ports on the back side of the Headliner. Reconnect the transplanted lights and speaker wiring and test them to ensure they work properly.

I. Attach Headliner to Right Rear Panel with a minimum of (3) 90935A196 Screws. Fasten bottom of the Right Rear Panel underneath the Lower Rear Panel with at least (1) 90935A196 Screw. See Figure 5.

J. Attach Headliner and Left Rear Panel with a minimum of (3) 90935A196 Screws. See Figure 6.

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K. Trim the passenger side of the Headliner to fit if required and re-attach the rubber door trim. Reinstall the emergency parachute grab handle. Ensure the Headliner is centered to the grab handle as shown in Figure 7.

Now close the door on the passenger side to hold the headliner in place and repeat those steps on the pilot side. Install Left and Right Pillar Covers or re-install the original OEM pillar covers if preferred. See Figure 8.

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L. Remove the back two AN3-4A bolts and AN960-10L washers from the AC-01011 Evaporator Cover Assembly. Align AC-01491 Bulkhead Cover Assembly with the AC-01011 holes and refasten the washers and bolts in their original location. Fasten (2) 90935A196 Black Screws through the top holes of AC-01491 and anchor it in to the right and left headliner sections. See Figure 9.
